

COVID Policy

APHA is requiring all in-person attendees to be up to date with their COVID-19 vaccination against the SARS-Cov-2 virus as defined by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control & Prevention. **Up to date is defined as a completed full primary series** (two shots of the Pfizer and Moderna COVID vaccine or one shot of the Johnson and Johnson product; or a comparably approved vaccine if you are an international attendee) **plus at least one booster**. We remind you that it can take up to six weeks to complete the full schedule for COVID vaccines that require two doses to achieve full efficacy. You will be required to show proof of vaccination during event check-in. **By registering for the event, you agree to be fully vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus by June 14.** Guests who are unable to show proof of vaccination will not be allowed to enter the event.

Mask Policy

Current APHA policy is that masks are optional for fully vaccinated people, but this may change based on local public health guidelines at the time of the meeting.

APHA strives to follow the best scientific guidance for wearing masks as an adjunct to other public health protections from respiratory viruses. To that end, attendees are free to wear masks while attending APHA events.
